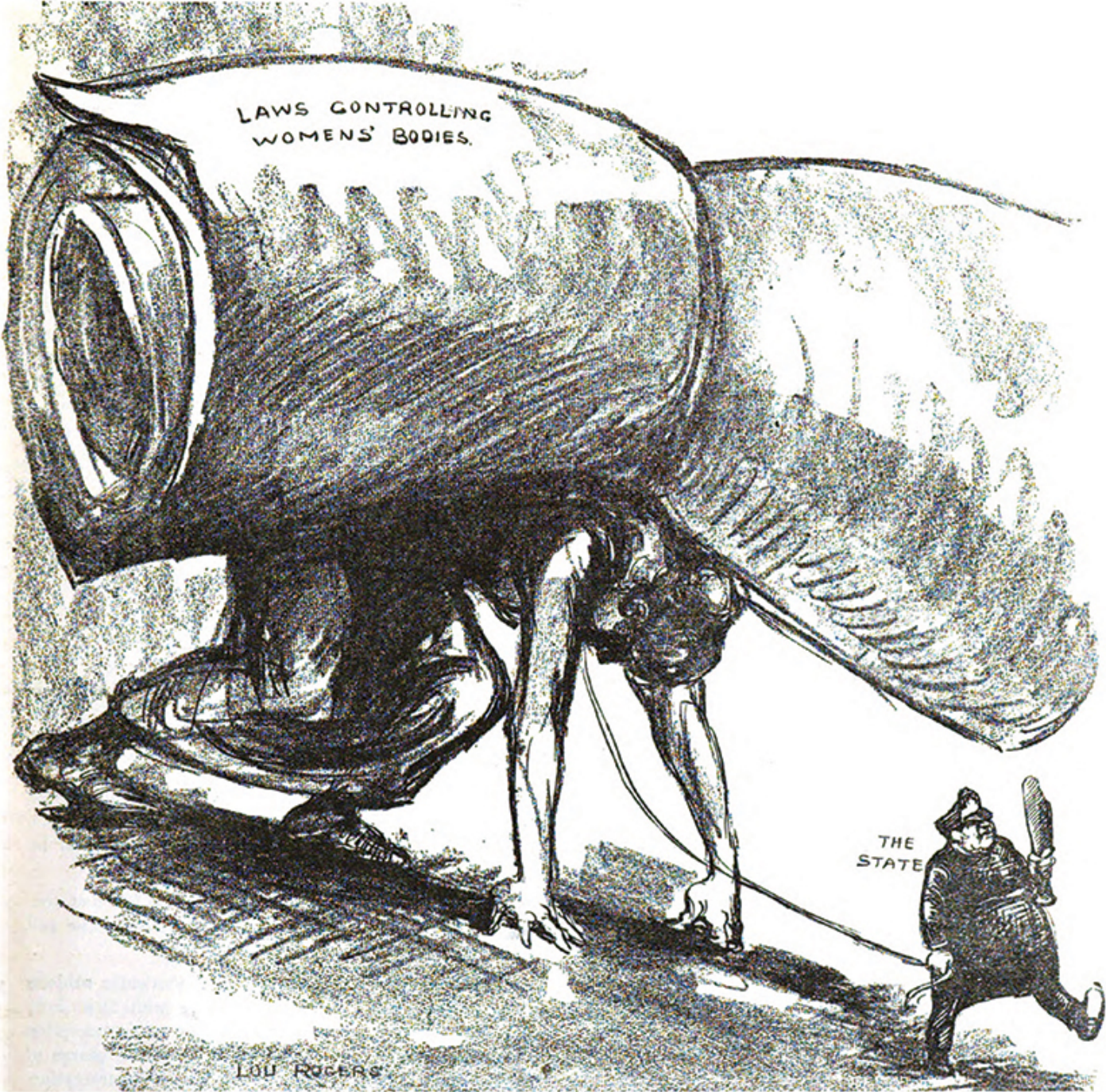


Note: "Anti" was a nickname for anti-suffragists, people who didn't want women to vote.



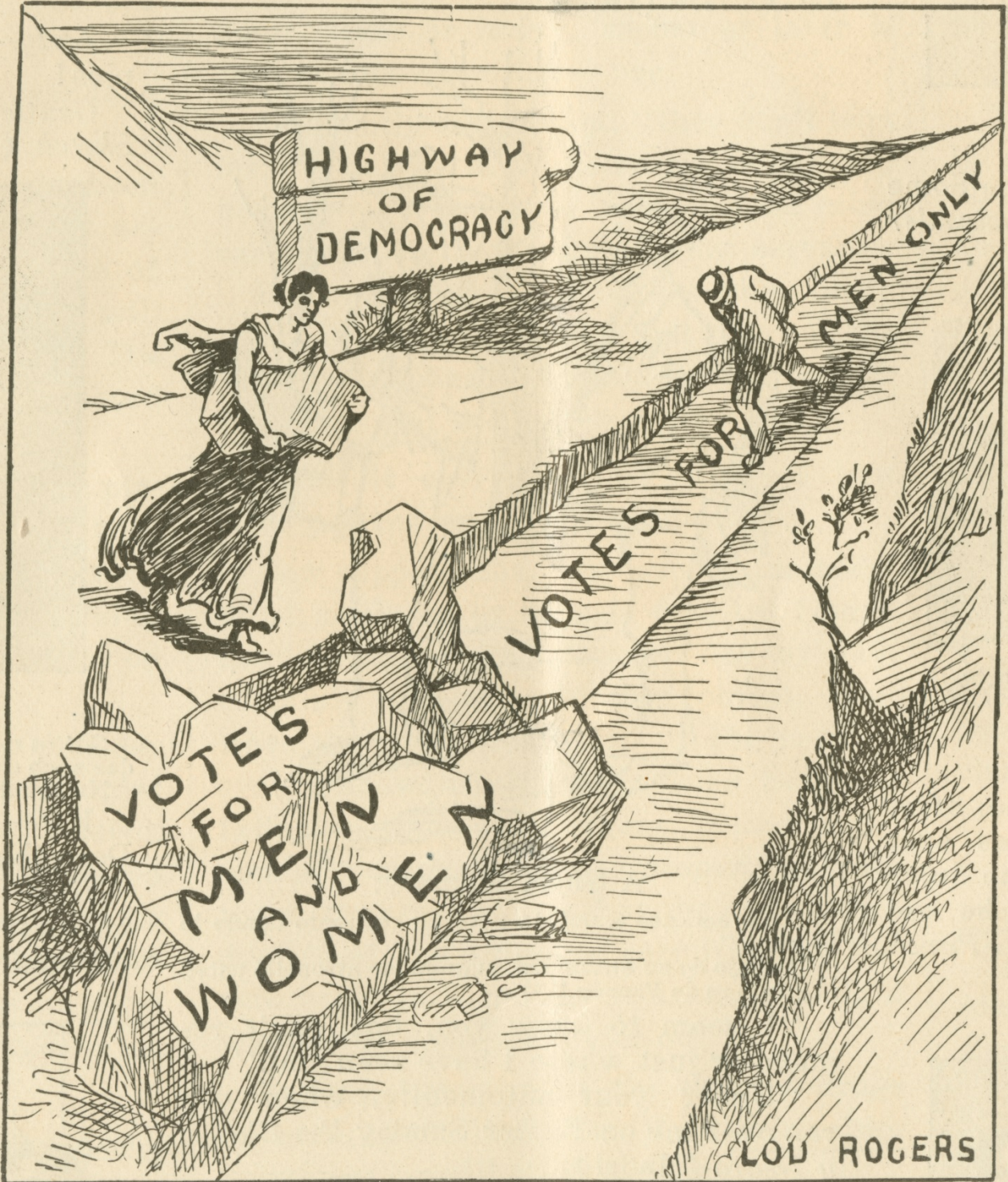

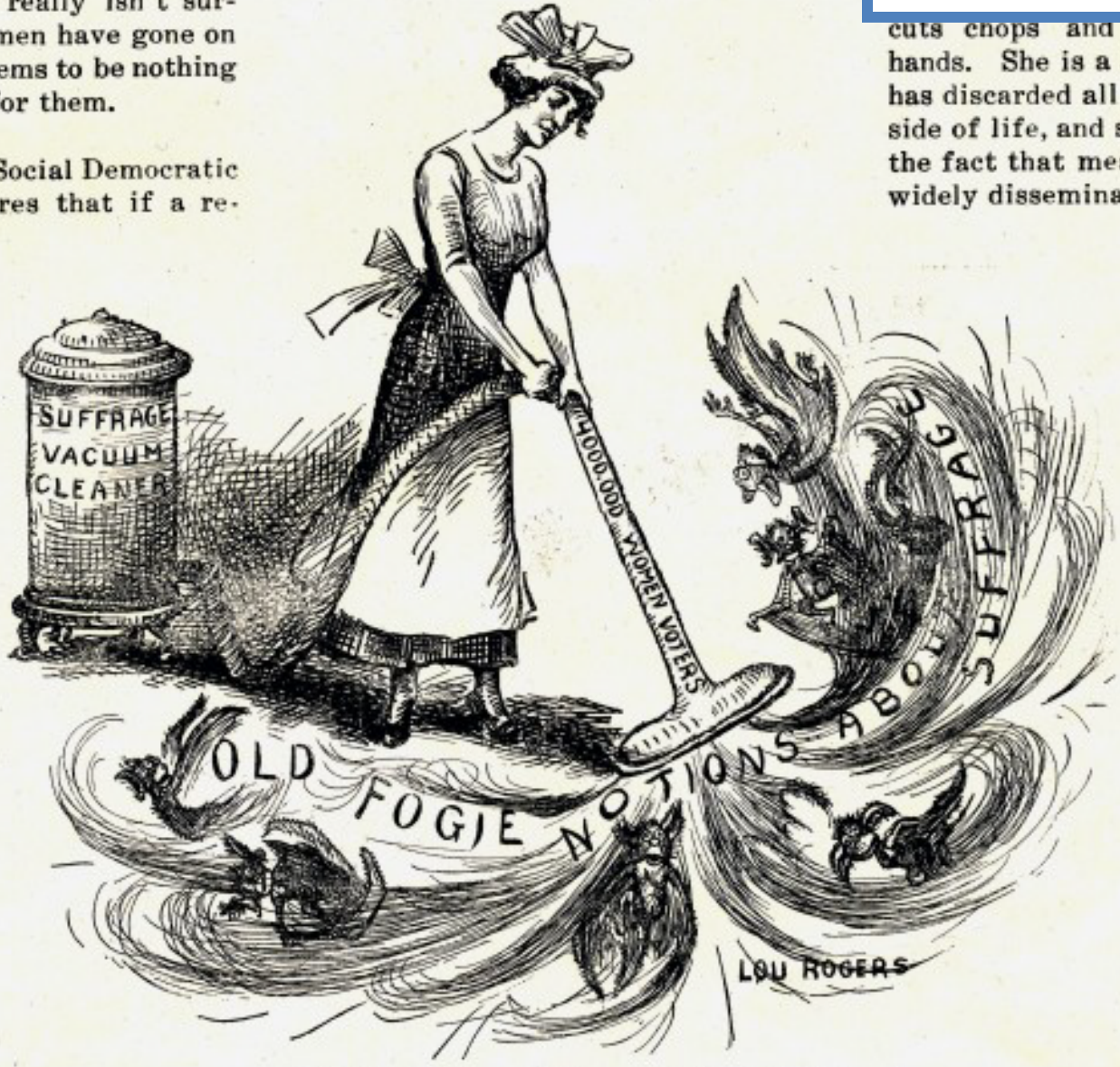
