



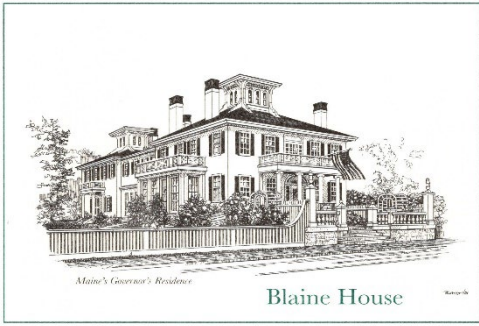

For more than 100 years the Blaine House has been home to Maine Governors and a destination for visitors from across the State of Maine and beyond. We welcome members of the public to visit and learn about the history of this home and the Governors and First Families that have resided here.

In order to preserve the safety of our Governor and the museum collections, all visitors are required to provide information for a security screening prior to your arrival. Tours must be requested through the Maine State Museum no less than 1 week prior to your scheduled tour or event. You may complete the form on the following page or submit a pdf of your list including the full name, date of birth and physical address for each adult in your party. Security forms must be received **no less than 3 business days prior** to your arrival. **Those individuals not listed will be unable to enter the grounds. All adult visitors will need to show a photo ID upon entering the grounds.** Minors must be accompanied by an adult.

All weapons, backpacks and large bags are prohibited on the grounds. Please note that the Governor's Residence is monitored by electronic surveillance.
